

## Robert Behrman Memorial Fund Established

Robert E. Behrman, partner in the firm of Behrman and Passell, which built the Bigelow Apartments, Downtown, died Tuesday, Feb. 2 after a month-long illness in Memorial Hospital, New York City.

The family R.E. Behrman has suggested that memorial contributions be made to the Robert E. Behrman Memorial Fund for Cancer Research, Mellon National Bank, University Branch, Oakland.

Mr. Behrman, 56, who was active in the construction of over 25 major apartment buildings in the city, served during the past five years also as a consultant with the U.S. Department of State's Agency for International Development. He lived at 1234 Murrayhill Ave., Squirrel Hill.

The State Department Agency worked with the Organization of American States in the construction of low income housing units in Central and South America.

A past president of the Irene Kaufmann Center, Mr. Behrman was secretary of the Americans for Democratic Action, Pittsburgh Chapter, and a member of the American Arbitration Society.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Beulah Behrman; three sons, Peter, Richard, and Eric Behrman; and a sister, Muriel Behrman.

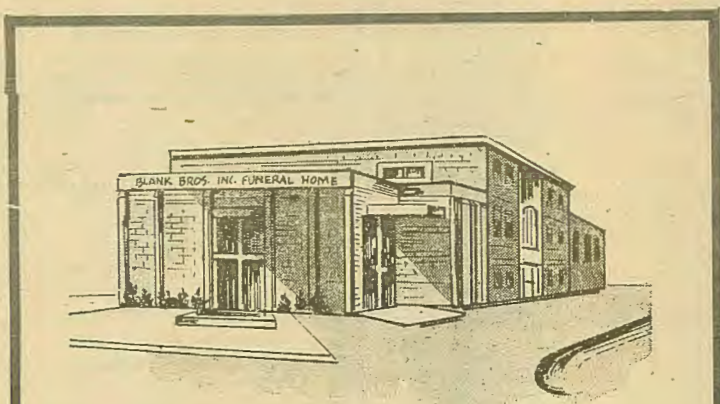
