BUENOS AIRES (JTA)-President Raul Alfonsin has appointed Jacobo Fiterman, a member of the presidium of the Latin American branch of the World Jewish Con-

gress, to the post of Secretary of Public Works for the Buenos Aires municipality.

Fiterman, an engineer who has long been active in Jewish affairs here, served until recently as president of the Argentine Zionist Organization. In November, he led a major public campaign in the country to mobilize support for efforts to persuade the United Nations General Assembly to repudiate its 1975 resolution equating Zionism with racism.
