

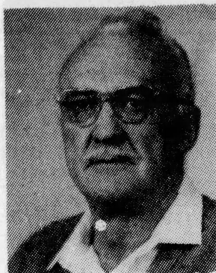
Dr. Carroll E. Heffron, 67, claimed by death

Dr. Carroll E. Heffron, 67, of 647 Canary Drive, Walla Walla, died Tuesday, Nov. 22 in a Seattle hospital. He was the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. John Heffron, Sunnyside pioneers.

He was born March 9, 1910 in Sunnyside, attended local schools and graduated from Sunnyside High School in 1928. He attended Whitman College, the University of Washington and graduated from the University of Oregon Medical School. He entered medical practice in Seattle until receiving a commission as a medical officer with the United States Air Force. Following his discharge from the service in 1946, he established a medical practice in Yakima. In 1958 he moved to Walla Walla and served as resident physician at the Washington State Penitentiary until retirement in 1972.

He married Catherine Mooney in Yakima on Nov. 26, 1936. She preceded him in death Aug. 11, 1969.

Survivors include four sons, Dr. John (Pat) Heffron, serving with the U.S. Air Force, Andrews Air Force Base, Washington D.C., Carroll Heffron Jr. and Tom Heffron, both of Seattle and Tim Heffron of
